- 1. The website does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookie files.
- 2. Cookie files (so-called "cookies") constitute IT data, in particular text files that are stored on the Website User's end device and are dedicated to the use of Website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the time of storage on the end device and a unique number.
- 3. The entity placing cookies on the Website User's end device and accessing them is the operator of http://krowarzywa.pl, Dobrze Sp. z o.o. Sp. k. company seated in Warsaw, 00-639 Warsaw, ul. Marszałkowska.27/35 LU-1, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XII Commercial Department of the National Court Register under the number KRS: 0000689920, Tax Identification Number: 7010473488, REGON: 360974542.
- 4. Cookies are used to:
- 5. adjusting the content of the Website pages to the User's preferences and optimizing the use of pages; these files, in particular, allow to recognize the device of the Website User and properly display the website, adjusted to his individual needs;
- 6. creating statistics that help to understand how Website Users use the pages, which allows improving their structure and content.
- 7. The Website uses two basic types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie file parameters or time of their removal by the User.
- 8. The Website uses the following types of cookies:
- 9. "Necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the Website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services that require authentication on the Website;
- 10. cookies used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect fraud in the field of authentication on the Website;
- 11. "Performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of Website pages;
- 12. "Functional" cookies, allowing "remembering" of the settings selected by the User and personalizing the User's interface, e.g. in the scope of the selected language or region of User's origin, font size, website appearance, etc.;
- 13. "Advertising" cookies, enabling users to provide advertising content adjusted better to their interests.
- 14. In many cases, software used for browsing websites (web browser) allows cookies to be stored in the User's device by default. Website Users can change their cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser's settings or inform them of each entry in the device of the Website User. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies are available in the software (web browser) settings.
- 15. The Website Operator informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.
- 16. Cookies placed on the Website User's end device may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Website operator.
